1. Commitment to Safety and Well-being:

- We maintain appropriate first aid and emergency response training.

2. Positive Role Modeling:

- We demonstrate good sportsmanship, respect, and integrity at all times.
- We treat all players, parents, officials, and opponents with respect and courtesy.
- We refrain from using abusive language, derogatory comments, or any behaviour that can be considered disrespectful or harmful.

3. Development and Growth:

- We focus on individual player development and skill improvement over winning at all costs.
- We encourage and support players to set personal goals and strive for self-improvement.
- We provide constructive feedback in a positive and respectful manner.

4. Inclusivity and Diversity:

- We create an inclusive and welcoming environment where every player feels valued, regardless of their background, skill level, or identity.
- We do not tolerate discrimination, harassment, or bullying of any kind.

5. Communication:

- We maintain open and honest communication with players, parents, and other team members.
- We listen to the concerns and feedback of players and parents, addressing them appropriately and in a timely manner.

6. Professionalism:

- We uphold a high standard of professionalism in our appearance, conduct, and interactions.
- We avoid engaging in any behaviour that could damage the reputation of the team, the organisation, or the sport.

7. Personal Boundaries:

- We maintain appropriate physical and emotional boundaries with players, ensuring a safe and comfortable environment for everyone.

8. Confidentiality:

- We respect the privacy of players and their families by not sharing personal or sensitive information without consent.

9. Adherence to Rules:

- We follow all league rules, regulations, and policies, ensuring fair play and a level playing field.
- We will meet and exceed standards of conduct and governance set by CIFA, CONCACAF, FIFA and the Cayman Islands Government.
- We encourage players to compete within the spirit of the game and respect the decisions of officials.

- We seek opportunities for professional development and stay informed about the latest coaching techniques, safety protocols, and youth development practices.

11. Payments and Commissions
